ONLINE TRAINING ON LANGUAGE LEARNING MODEL 2019

1. PROGRAMME

SEAMEO QITEP in Language will conduct online training on

- a. Discovery Learning Model (29 July – 30 August 2019)
- b. Project-based Learning Model (2 September – 26 September 2019)
- c. Text-based Learning Model (30 September – 4 November 2019)

2. TARGET PARTICIPANTS

Language teachers (Arabic, English, German, Indonesian, Japanese, Mandarin, etc.) in lower and higher secondary school from Southeast Asia Region.

During the sessions, additional to the presentation from the resource persons, the participants can interact with resource persons through online discussions and assignments.
